



2004 Syrah Crane Ranch Vineyards Napa Valley

Crane Brothers Napa Valley Wines are all estate grown, single vineyard, and very small production from the family owned Crane Ranch Vineyard. Third generation Napa Valley natives Michael and Robert Crane and winemaker Al Perry have made great wines together since the 2001 vintage. Located in The Oak Knoll District of the Napa Valley, the 9 acre Crane Ranch Vineyard is planted on bench land and hillside, above the valley floor. The unique microclimate of warm sunny days and cool breezy evenings, along with our custom hand farming, allow our Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Petit Verdot grapes to develop intense flavor, color, and aroma.

Deep crimson/ Purple showing lush black raspberry, blueberry, black pepper, mocha, minerals and bacon fat. The sexy middle is exploding with black fruits, violets, crème de cassis and sweet oak. Beautifully structured with a full-bodied yet elegant finish that keeps impressing as it opens up in the glass
